Wisconsin Passes New Social Host Law, Closing Loophole

In Wisconsin, [an appeals court decided that a local social host law could only apply to a person's business, not to their home](#). Last month, the legislature of Wisconsin took action to clarify the issue, and the governor signed their bill into law. Now, local social host laws are enforceable once again.

One of the sponsors of the bill, Andre Jacque, pointed out that the life-saving potential of social host laws, saying "Green Bay (is) one of the few metro areas in the entire country where you have over half the traffic fatalities having alcohol as a significant contributing factor."
