By combining the Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF) with the NIATx Model for quality and process improvement, participants learn a structured approach to planning and delivering evidence-based strategies. The focus on cultural responsiveness ensures that interventions are tailored to the specific needs of diverse communities. Through a blend of workshops, webinars, and individualized technical assistance, coalitions gain practical tools to increase efficiency, deepen community impact, and foster measurable long-term success in their prevention initiatives.


