



Ohio's Youth-Led Prevention Network is divided into 5 regions.


The map's color-coded regions illustrate how many We Are Change Rally attendees participated from each Ohio region.



As part of OYLPN's three-year strategic prevention framework, youth participants identified a specific problem to focus on. In 2022, data revealed a significant gap in the number of young people who reported having a trusted adult. In response, OYLPN centered its efforts on fostering meaningful youth-adult connections and strengthening the role of adult allies.

Through the pilot mentorship program, three established youth-led groups and their adult allies conducted boots-on-the-ground work, providing technical assistance, one-on-one coaching, and program refinement to new groups. Expanding Ohio's Youth-Led Prevention Network played a vital role in strengthening and amplifying connections between adults and youth.

Looking to the Future

Expand prevention messaging through creative formats, such as art showcases, digital campaigns, short videos, or community events.
